Question 1:

A chocolate bar and three sweets cost 35p.

Two chocolate bars cost 40p.

How much does a sweet cost?

Question 2:

At the shop, Harry buys a carton of juice and a banana. It costs 55p.

Jim buys three cartons of juice. It costs 90p.

How much does a banana cost?

Task B

Question 1:

It costs £21 for three adults and two children to go to the cinema.

It costs £10 for two adults to go to the cinema.

How much does it cost for a child to go to the cinema?

Question 2:

A bat and a ball cost £1 in total. The bat costs 40p more than the ball.

How much does the ball cost?

*Extension: Design your own questions where you need **two clues** to work out the answer.*

Task C

Question 1:

It costs £44 for five adults and two children to go bowling.

It costs £28 for four adults to go bowling.

How much does it cost for a child to go bowling?

Question 2:

A racket and a ball cost £5 in total. The racket costs £4 more than the ball. **How much does the ball cost?**

*Extension: Design your own questions where you need **two clues** to work out the answer.*
